

SUBJECT TITLE: NEWARK CASTLE, ST MONANS, FIFE

Warning: Critically loose masonry. Visiting not advisable except in dry quiet weather. Doorway lintel of a basement vault unsupported at one end. Exposed anchorage.

Location description: Half a mile west of St Monans, Fife.

Chart No: Imray C27 Firth of Forth **Lat/Long:** 56⁰ 12'.2 N 02⁰ 46'.6 W

OS 1:50,000 sheet number: 59 **National Grid Ref.:** NO 518012

Subject description: Cliff top castle ruin

Approach by sea: Keep clear of the Long Shank, a reef to the east of the castle.

Directions by land: Follow the sign posted Fife coastal footpath west from St Monans. Castle visible from miles around.

Anchoring / Mooring: Anchor off in 5 metres taking care to avoid numerous creel markers. Limited sheltered from the North only.

Landing: Sandy cove immediately west of the castle
